PROJECT IDENTIFIER EXPLANATION
 IGEN uses a project identifier system intended to communicate or denote all the important aspects of a project. IGEN Staff assign your project a number using this system. The project identifier system captures the college district, whether the district is a general or lead member, the sub-award type, the fiscal year, whether the project is one of multiple projects, and even the sustainability area focused on with the project. For all invoicing, it is vital for member colleges to include the project identifier.
