PROJECT IDENTIFIER EXPLANATION

IGEN uses a project identifier system intended to communicate or denote all the important aspects of a project. As a project owner, you can assign your project a number using this system. The project identifier system captures the college district, whether the district is a general or lead member, the sub-award type, the fiscal year, whether the project is one of multiple projects, and even the sustainability area focused on with the project. If the member has assigned a tentative project identifier, IGEN staff will review the identifier and may revise it. If a number has not been assigned at the time of application, IGEN staff will assign a number. For all invoicing, it is vital for member colleges to include the project identifier.
